



## Important facts about Frontline... Did you know?



Fleas will die within 12 hours of contact with your treated pet. Ticks will die within 48 hours of contact with your treated pet. It takes greater than 48 hours for adult ticks to transmit bacterial diseases.

Frontline is a very safe flea/tick preventative:

- Safe for dogs and cats (Advantix, BioSpot and Hartz products can be toxic to cats)
- Safe for puppies or kittens as young as 8 weeks of age
- Safe for pets that are pregnant or nursing
- Frontline is NOT absorbed internally –no need to worry about systemic side effects nor interactions with other medications.
- A cat can eat 29 tubes of Frontline with NO adverse effects
- A dog can eat 87 tubes of Frontline with NO adverse effects



Frontline has a unique carrier that allows the product to disperse into the oil glands deep in your pet's skin which protects it from being degraded by UV light and from being washed off even after bathing, swimming or grooming.

**BEWARE** of look-alike products that are coming out on the market—although they contain the same active ingredient (fipronil) – they do NOT use the same carrier.



Ticks carry a variety of disease causing microbes like Lyme, Anaplasma, Ehrlichia, Bartonella, Babesia and Tularemia to name a few. Ticks can transmit these infections in a single bite.

- Tick bites and tick borne infections are completely preventable
- Lyme disease is the only tick borne disease in which a vaccine is available
- Some ticks saliva contains substances that can result in temporary paralysis of your pet!



Flea bites can cause allergic reactions in some pets. If your dog/cat ingests a flea, they can become infested with tapeworms.
