



Growing Equestrians Scholarship

The Lodi Veterinary Care Equine Team strives to help individuals further their equestrian knowledge and improve their horsemanship skills. This scholarship is to be used towards educational expenses with the goal of keeping young people involved in the equine industry.

- Deadline for scholarship applications is: December 1, 2019. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
- The LVC Growing Equestrian Scholarship is offering two scholarships per year of up to \$500 each.
- You will be notified via mail in January regarding the status of your application.
- The LVC GES is intended to be used towards furthering education in an equine field of study, such as: college, tech school, farrier school, massage school, clinics, club expenses (Pony Club, FFA, 4H), conventions, and working student positions, etc.
- If you have any questions regarding the application, please contact Lodi Veterinary Care, Equine Department.

Criteria:

- Applicant must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2019
- Applicant must be a current equine client of LVC or have a signed Letter of Nomination from a current equine client. Current clients are defined as having an equine patient that has been seen by a LVC doctor within the last 12 months.
- Applicant must not have been awarded the LVC Growing Equestrians Scholarship in the past.
- Funds must be used in the calendar year awarded.
- Those awarded the Scholarship are requested to give a short presentation at the 2021 Client Seminar describing how the funds were used. The Client Seminar is a dinner and education event held annually for our Equine Clients, typically on a Saturday in February. If you are unable to attend the Client Seminar, we would be happy to work with you to develop an alternative presentation.
